### RULES

- A. All exhibitors must purchase a Membership, Season Pass, or \$10.00 Gate Admission Ticket to enter.
- B. A registration or recordation certificate may be required for animals of any age if the show so chooses.
- C. Base date is August 29, 2026, the date the animal is to be judged.
- D. Copies of the registration certificate or the stamped application will not be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
- E. Each exhibitor may enter more than 2 per class, but only 2 premiums per class will be paid to any one exhibitor.
- F. Health papers and visual check by the barn superintendent before unloading will be strictly enforced. No horned goats will be allowed.
- G. There will be a combined Doe Show and a separately sanctioned Jr. Doe Show. **DOUBLE SANCTIONED PAYBACK SHOW**
- H. **SEE INSPECTION AND HEALTH REQUIREMENTS.**
- I. The order of the show is not subject to change.
- J. The Original Registration Certificate or duplicate application stamped by the ADGA office is required for all animals six months or older and **MUST** be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show.
- K. This show is for the following breeds: ALL OTHER PUREBREED, ALPINE, LAMANCHA, NIGERIAN DWARF, NUBIAN, RECORDED GRADE, SAANEN, TOGGENBURG
- L. This show is sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association and their rules shall govern. **ONLY** American Dairy Goat Association, American Goat Society, and Canadian Goat Society registered, recorded or applied-for animals may be shown in an official American Dairy Goat Association Show.
- M. Best in Show will be awarded for the Jr. Doe Show and combined Doe Show.

## RULES

- A. All exhibitors must purchase a Membership or Season Pass to enter.
- B. All birds must be banded.
- C. All entries will be classified.
- D. All Poultry must have health papers, blood tests and papers before unloading.
- E. Each Exhibitor will be responsible to furnish bedding, a balanced ration, care and feeding of all birds entered and/or exhibited during the fair. "All poultry exhibitors are required to feed, water, and clean their exhibits **by 10:00 am each day**. Premiums will be withheld if pens are not cleaned daily and animals are not fed and watered. Repeat offenders will not be able to show the following year."
- F. Each poultry exhibitor must show proof of one of the following (does not include waterfowl):
  1. Poultry exhibited were obtained from a hatchery of origin which is a participant in the National Poultry Improvement Plans for the eradication of disease (all commercial Ohio hatcheries meet this requirement); OR
  2. Poultry are from a flock which has had a negative test for Pullorum disease within 12 months; OR
  3. Poultry have had negative test for Pullorum disease within 90 days.
  4. Regardless, all birds must have proof of negative Pullorum.
- G. Previous exhibitors and county residents will be given first priority.
- H. **SEE INSPECTION AND HEALTH REQUIREMENTS RULES.**
